Our New Regional School

The Pastors/Principals Steering Committee for the regionalization of our schools has continued to meet throughout the summer. Some parishioners within our four parishes have expressed concern via the www.CareNews.org website about how grade levels will be divided among the future school site(s), and will children of the same family need to attend more than one school site. As educators and administrators we strongly believe in our K-8 school model. If more than one school site is needed, then both will enroll students K-8 or at least 1-8 if an incoming kindergarten would ever be too small. Please continue to ask questions and share ideas with us as we continue to prepare throughout this year for an exciting future!

The Steering Committee had scheduled a community meeting in September. That meeting is being postponed because the date conflicts with one of the High School Information Nights. Beginning this school year, the High Schools are no longer visiting individual schools to recruit, but holding large gatherings at a host grade school. It's like a one stop event with 19 high schools present to discuss/share their mission. Traditionally, our eighth graders met and spoke with the High Schools during the school day, so parents and eighth graders will find these High School Information Nights invaluable in making their high school decisions.

The Steering Committee will reschedule their community meeting later this Fall.
