### Athletics

Father Tom Dennemann, along with members of all four parishes' athletic programs, met on Tuesday, January 29, 2008. During this meeting, they unanimously agreed that the teams should be school teams rather than individual parish teams to promote unity in the school itself.

This group has begun working together planning for the future programs for the school teams. They have set up future meeting dates, are prioritizing the areas they need to discuss and will proceed to come together as an athletic association for the school representing their parishes.

There was a tremendous spirit of cooperation at the meeting. We will all continue to work together to develop the constitution for the sports program, to work on schedules and all the various situations that need to be determined and decided.

The next meeting date will be Tuesday, February 26.

### BUSES

There continues to be concern over the busing situation for our new school. While specific arrangements cannot be made at this time, the Steering Committee wanted to assure you that the state law mandates that the local public school district transport non-public school students to their school on the dates and at the times that the school is in session **OR** provide reimbursement to the parents of the non-public students in lieu of transporting by bus. Additional information about transportation, starting and dismissal times for the new Regional School will be given as they become available.
