this week's Q&A's

Mr. Mike Johnson, principal of Our Lady of Grace Catholic School, continues his efforts to prepare Our Lady of Grace to open this coming fall. Once again, Mr. Johnson also takes time to answer questions you have posted on the C.A.R.E. News web site.

Q: How soon will home rooms be posted?

A: Homerooms will be posted in early August (probably around August 10). We will post them at our covenant parishes as well as in the window of the main office (to be viewed from outside).

Q: When are we going to know an exact answer on the bussing issue?

A: Each district has a listing of our students and is in the process of routing their buses. If you have not filled out a transportation request form from your district be sure to do that. Your district will send you a bus card in the mail sometime around the second week of August. You can call your transportation department to see if they currently have any details available.

Q: When will Spirit wear sweatshirts and t-shirts be going on sale?

A: We are currently looking at samples and pricing for our logo sweatshirts (the sweatshirts that can be worn with the uniform). As far as spirit wear goes we will have some t-shirts and other items available within the next two weeks. If all goes well, they will be available at the family game night and the skating party.

Q: I was interested in knowing who the new 5/6 SS teacher is going to be. Can you update that on the faculty list?

A: Sue Hotze is going to be teaching grades 5-6 social studies. Sue comes to the position having taught social studies at the intermediate level for a number of years. The faculty list on the CARE News site has been updated to reflect this change.
