Dear Parents of Prospective Kindergarteners,

Our new regional parish school located at 2940 W. Galbraith Road will begin Kindergarten registration February 19th! Our school will offer all day Kindergarten classes with a half-day option as a possibility depending on parental interest. Click [HERE](#) to see the tuition schedule. There is a \$50.00 non-refundable registration fee to be returned with the initial paperwork to secure your child's enrollment. Any checks may be made out to your parish. Please submit the registration form (Click [HERE](#)) and fee with your child's birth and Baptismal certificates. Forms are due by February 29th to your parish's school office. Your registration will not be complete until all paperwork is received and acknowledged.

The new regional school hopes to have three Kindergarten classrooms with room for additional classroom(s) if registration exceeds expected demand. Approximately 20-25 students per room are the projected class size for Kindergarten.

The faculty for the regional school has not yet been hired. Once the Kindergarten teachers and any aides are hired, a Meet the Teacher Night will be held in the spring. An assessment of incoming Kindergarteners skills will also take place in the near future.

Our Kindergarten curriculum will be based on the Archdiocese of Cincinnati's Graded Course of Study. The Archdiocese creates their course of studies by a representative committee of teachers. Those teachers examine the State of Ohio standards and derive the Archdiocesan courses of study from their year-long committee meetings.

Have you heard about Ohio's EdChoice Scholarship program? You can check out the details on www.EdChoice.ohio.gov. Ohio is providing a limited number of these state-funded scholarships to students whose public school of attendance would be a low-performing school. The scholarship would cover the tuition costs, but any fees (field trip, lunch, or cafeteria fees) would be paid by the family. Contact your parish school office for details.

We have 600 students registered for our new school in Grades 1-8 already, and we hope to add plenty of Kindergarten students too. We're anxious to include your child's enrollment. We hope you will come and add life to our new school for the next nine years!
